There is an additional charge, paid by the Bidder, for shipping and handling fees for overnight mail. UCSF-DMM will charge fees according to option selected in shipping documents to you. Only bidders who participate in both the Conference and the Job Walk in their entirety will be allowed to bid on the Project as prime contractors. Sealed Bids for Lump Sum and Alternates will not be accepted after 3:00 PM, July 25, 2008.

Bids will be opened after 3:05 PM, July 25, 2008.

Prior to the Bid Deadline and after bid opening, the University may establish a new Bid Deadline no earlier than 24 hours from the prior Bid Deadline, if no material changes are made to the bidding documents, and no earlier than 72 hours if material changes are made. In such event the University will, at a minimum, notify all persons or entities known by the University to have received a complete set of Bidding Documents and who has provided a street address and/or facsimile number for receipt of any written pre-bid communications.

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Bid, excluding alternates, shall accompany each Bid. The Surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120).

The successful bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the bidding documents and to pay prevailing wage rates at the location of the work.

The successful Bidder will be required to have the following California current and active contractor's license at the time of submission of the Bid:
