Re: Block 18 Surcharge Project Notification

Dear Parents,

During the planned, annual facility closure scheduled for August 23- September 1, and over three Saturdays following the closure, on September 6, 13 and 20, 2014, UCSF Capital Programs is planning to complete the final phase of the Block 18 Surcharge Project. During these planned center closures, unneeded soils will be hauled off campus to prepare the parcels for future development. While there is no immediate plan to develop Block 18, the Surcharge Project is a necessary step to prepare for development in the future.

Following Surcharge Project activity and prior to each center re-opening the following measures will be taken: dust suppressant will be installed on uncovered areas and a geotextile fabric will cover soils. The screen mesh fencing surrounding the Surcharge Project activity will remain intact.

Additional mitigations of roof sweeping, power washing of play areas and equipment, inspection and as needed replacement of interior HEPA air filters will occur prior to each center re-opening. Sandbox sand will be removed during the August closure, and be replaced following the completion of the Surcharge Project.

We appreciate that you may have questions regarding this activity. **You are invited to an open forum for parents on Thursday, July 10, 5:00 – 5:50pm, in Rock Hall Auditorium, 1550 4th Street.** Representatives from UCSF Capital Programs, Environmental Health and Safety, Family Services and Bright Horizons will be in attendance. Associate Director, Capital Programs, Jodi Soboll, will present the project timeline in detail, and an open forum for questions will be provided. For parents without UCSF ID cards, please note that photo ID is required to enter Rock Hall.

This project, managed by Capital Programs, has been a multi-year effort. For families who are new to the University Child Care Center at Mission Bay, background information may be helpful. UCSF commenced the development of its Mission Bay Campus in 1999 pursuant to a Master Plan for 2.65 million gross square feet (GSF) of development on the original 43-acre campus north of 16th Street. In accordance with UCSF's Long Range Development Plan, development projects are currently underway and are anticipated to be ongoing. Projects such as the Block 18 Surcharge Project will prepare the land potentially for, among other things, a permanent, expanded Child Care facility – the specific site and timeline, and the approval of which are still yet to be determined and, as always, remain subject to funding and Regental approval.

Development at Mission Bay is subject to, among other regulations, the Mission Bay Risk Management Plan (RMP). The oversight agency for the RMP is the Regional

Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB). The RMP was approved by the California Environmental Protection Agency with input from the San Francisco Department of Public Health.
