IMPORTANT PARKING POLICIES – PLEASE READ and CHECK EACH ITEM

Mt. Zion staff permits are considered temporary and will be available until such time as demand for patient parking exceeds the supply of available resources in the 2420 Sutter Street garage.

Permit holders will be given a minimum of two-months notice prior to displacement, if necessary. Permits will be rescinded based on a last-in first-out formula, such that individuals who have possessed permits the shortest duration will be displaced first.

Mt. Zion staff carpool permit holders must have two or more vehicle occupants when parking in the garage. The primary permit holder must be in the vehicle at all times when using a carpool permit.

Permit parking privileges cannot be transferred, loaned, sold, or otherwise utilized by anyone other than the designated permit holder at any time.

Permit fees are based on possession not usage.

Refunds can be made only from the date the permit and garage access card is returned to the UCSF parking office.

Permits must be displayed at all times when parking in a UCSF parking facility.

Vehicles may not be parked in any UCSF facility in excess of 72 consecutive hours. Permits must be used to both enter and exit a UCSF garage.

The Regents of the University of California shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to bicycles or motor vehicles or to any property contained therein for any cause whatsoever, while such bicycles or vehicles are parked on university property.
