1. Park at your own risk. The Regents of The University of California shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to bicycles or motor vehicles or to any property contained therein for any cause whatsoever, while such bicycles or vehicles are parked on University property.
2. Bicycles, which are not moved for a period of 7 days or longer, will be tagged for removal and be impounded.
3. Bicycle locks may not be attached to storage racks if they are not securing a bicycle. All such locks found attached to racks longer than 7 days will be tagged for removal.
4. Impounded bicycles will be held for 90 days and the owner of record, if any, will be notified by mail. Owners may reclaim their bicycles from Transportation Services during the time period with appropriate identification. Thereafter, the bicycle becomes property of the University and will be disposed of in accordance with standard University procedures.
5. ID Badges will take up to 72 hours to be activated.
